Did you know once your child turns 18 you no longer have automatic access to:

- *your child's health records*
- *your child's medical condition*
- *your child's education records (without a FERPA waiver)*

It's finally happened. Your child is grown, flown, off to college or other new adventures. While you probably still have them on your health insurance policy, they are now legal adults and you don't have the same control you once had. Accidents and illnesses happen. Be sure your child has the basic legal documents **everyone** should have.
